**NOTICE INVITING BIDS (NIB) FROM PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS**  
**(International Competitive Bidding)**

**DISTRICT- PAPUMPARE, ARUNACHAL PRADESH, INDIA**

**1.0** The North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Limited (NEEPCO), a Public Sector Enterprise under the Ministry of Power, Government of India, presently undertaking construction of **Pare Hydro Electric Project (2 X 55 MW)** located in the Papumpare District of the State of Arunachal Pradesh in India, invites sealed bids, with 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days validity from prospective bidders under the Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding system through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) route for **PACKAGE – IV** (Transformers and Switchyard) consisting of the following work:

Design, Engineering, Manufacturing, Assembly, Testing and Inspection at Works, Packing, loading & Forwarding, Supply, Transportation to site, Unloading and Storage at site, Insurance, Handling at Site, complete Erection, Commissioning, successful performance testing and handing over of entire **Package-IV**, comprising of:

- i) 132 kV Switchyard and accessories including associated civil works.
- ii) Generator Transformers, Station Service Transformer, Station Auxiliary Transformers.

- iii) Interconnection between Power House and Switchyard.
- iv) 33 KV System.

The estimated value for the entire scope of work mentioned above is INR 154 Million (Indian Rupees One Hundred and Fifty Four Million only) approximately.

## **2.0 Bidding Procedure:**

The Bidder shall submit the Bid under the Single-Stage Two-Envelope bidding system as follows:

**Envelope No. 1:** Shall contain Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), documents in support of qualifying requirements and Techno-Commercial Bid.

**Envelope No. 2:** Shall contain Price Bid. Price Bids of only those Bidders who qualify in Techno-Commercial evaluation shall be opened.

## **3.0 Time of Completion: 29 (Twenty Nine) months from the date of issue of Letter of Intent.**

**4.0 Earnest Money Deposit:** Earnest Money Deposit shall be Rs. 3100000.00 (Indian Rupees Thirty One Lakh) only or equivalent US Dollars / Japanese Yen/Swiss Francs/Euros etc. Bids without the Earnest Money Deposit shall be rejected.

## **5.0 Qualifying Requirements:**

### **5.1 Technical Experience:**

#### **5.1.1 Switchyard:**

Individual Company/Firm or Joint Venture/Consortium, shall have designed, engineered, erected, tested and commissioned 1(one) Switchyard of 132 KV category or above, which is in satisfactory operation for a period of at least 3(three) consecutive years within a period of 7(seven) years prior to the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bids. Details, including year-wise value of work executed, clients, proof of satisfactory completion of work and operation of such installations shall be furnished.

#### **5.1.2 Transformers:**

Individual Company/Firm or Joint Venture/Consortium shall have designed, manufactured, tested, supplied and supervised installation and commissioning of 132 KV class or above

Power Transformer of at least 20 MVA capacity in case of single phase and 60 MVA in case of three phase. Transformers should have been in satisfactory operation as Generator Transformers for at least 3(three) consecutive years within a period of 7(seven) years prior to the date of opening of Techno-Commercial Bids. Details, including year-wise value of work executed, clients, proof of satisfactory completion of work and operation of such installations from the clients shall be furnished.

## **5.2 Annual Turnover:**

Average Annual Turnover during the last 3(three) years, ending last day of the previous financial year, should be at least INR 47 Million (Indian Rupees Forty Seven Million) Only or equivalent US Dollars/ Japanese Yen/ Swiss Francs/Euros etc..

Complete Annual Reports along with the audited balance sheets and other financial statements for the last 3(three) years, ending last day of the previous financial year, should be furnished for evaluation of the financial criteria.

## **5.3 Joint Venture Bidders:**

Individual Company/Firm who do not individually fulfil the requirements indicated above can form Joint Venture / Consortium with another partner and its partner shall have a legally binding agreement for joint and several responsibilities and should submit copies of such agreements with the Bid. In the event of Joint Venture, the role of each partner, along with name of the Lead Partner, must clearly be indicated in the Joint Venture Agreement. In no case shall the Joint Venture have more than 2(two) partners. One of the partners shall be nominated as Lead Partner, and his authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a Power of Attorney signed by legally authorized signatory(s) of the other partner. The Lead Partner shall be authorized by the Joint Venture to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of the Joint Venture, and the entire execution of the Contract, including payments, shall be done exclusively with the Lead Partner.

5.3.1 In case of Joint Venture/Consortium, all its partners shall have a legally binding agreement for joint and several responsibilities. The detailed qualifying criteria of Lead Partner and the other partner are as below:

- i) There shall be 2(two) partners in the Joint Venture/Consortium, with a minimum holding of 60% for the Lead Partner.
- ii) The Lead Partner of Joint Venture/Consortium shall fully meet the following requirements:

- a) Design, Engineering, Supply, Erection, Testing and Commissioning of at least 1(one) Switchyard of 132 KV category or above.
  - b) Holding of Joint Venture/Consortium of not less than 60%.
  - c) Average Annual Turnover of not less than percentage share in Joint Venture.
- iii) The other partner of Joint Venture/Consortium shall individually meet the following requirements:
- a) Design, Manufacture, Testing, Supply and Supervision of installation and Commissioning of 132 KV class or above Power Transformers of at least 20 MVA capacity in case of single phase and 60 MVA capacity in case of three phase.
  - b) Average Annual Turnover of not less than percentage share in Joint Venture.
- iv) Individual Company/Firm or Joint Venture/Consortium shall collectively satisfy, as a whole, the requirements specified under paras 5.1 and 5.2 above. Relevant experience of each partner shall be counted for the purpose of assessing experience of this Joint Venture/Consortium. However, parties claiming to have past experience by virtue of being a partner of a Joint Venture/Consortium, while executing particular works in the past, shall also have to produce documentary evidence of their role and scope of work in the aforesaid Joint Venture/Consortium, which only shall be counted for the purpose of assessing experience of this Joint Venture/Consortium.

**5.4 Authenticated documentary evidence in support of qualifying requirements, as mentioned under Serial No. 5.1 to 5.3 above, shall be submitted in a separate envelope in the envelope containing Techno-Commercial bids, at the time of submission of bids. For qualifying requirements specified at Serial No. 5.1 to 5.3 above, the documents should be in the form of Certificate of Clients / Owners/Users. Bids submitted without fulfilling the qualifying requirements shall be rejected.**

**6.0** Bidders are requested to note the dates for purchase, submission and opening of bid documents as below:

- 6.1** In the event of the date specified for bid receipt and opening being declared as a closed holiday for NEEPCO, the due date for submission of bids and opening of bids will be the following working day at the appointed times.
- 6.2** Bid Documents may be obtained from the Office of the Executive Director (Contracts and Procurement), NEEPCO, Brookland Compound, Lower New Colony, Shillong -793 003, Meghalaya, India (Phone No. 91-364-2224582 and Fax No. +91-364-2222578) from 1000 hrs(Indian Standard Time) to 1700 hrs (Indian Standard Time) with effect from **3<sup>rd</sup> March,2010** on working days, on payment of INR 10,000.00(Indian Rupees Ten Thousand only) or equivalent US Dollar / Japanese Yen/Swiss Francs/ Euros etc., towards the cost of Bid Documents, in the form of Demand Draft / Banker’s Cheque pledged in favour of NEEPCO Ltd. and payable at Shillong. NEEPCO shall also promptly despatch the documents by Registered Airmail, if so requested. Under no circumstances shall NEEPCO be held responsible for late delivery or loss of documents so mailed.
- 6.3** Interested bidders who fulfil the qualifying requirements as indicated at Serial 5 above, may also download the Bid Documents from NEEPCO website **www.neepco.gov.in** with effect from **3<sup>rd</sup> March,2010** and submit their bids to the Office of the Executive Director (Contracts and Procurement), NEEPCO, Brookland Compound, Lower New Colony, Shillong-793003, Meghalaya, India at the appointed date and time as mentioned above. In the event the Bid Documents are downloaded from NEEPCO’s website, the cost of the Bid Documents, in the form of Demand Draft/Banker’s cheque drawn in favour of NEEPCO Ltd. Payable at Shillong, shall be compulsorily submitted alongwith bids. Any such bid submitted without cost of Bid Document shall be rejected.
- 6.4** Late receipt of request for issuance of Bid Documents, either by hand or by post, shall not be entertained.

- 7.0 Every page of the Bid Documents shall be signed and stamped with proper seal by the bidders and submitted along with the bids.
- 8.0 NEEPCO reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to annul the bidding process and reject all the bids for any justified and genuine grounds, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidders, nor does it have any obligation to inform the bidders of the ground for the action of NEEPCO.
